Oh yes.

EXPERIENCES AT ST. PATRICKS SCHOOL AT ANADARKO:

(When did you first start to school?)

1908 and '09. I just went for a short term in 1908, and then after that in 1909 that's when the school burned down in up at mission.

(What school was that?)

St. Patrick's Indian School.

(Was that in Anadarko?)

Oh, yes. They just practically abolished it now. They practically tore it down just last uh, school was abandoned I guess through the various channels of our people in town. They built the church up there and then the first thing you know they decided to do away with that.

(Is that the school where the Catholic church is?)

Yes, uhuh.

(On Highway 9?)

Yes. I went there practically all my life except for 1913 and 14. I was late and didn't get to enroll so I had to go to Riverside. For that one term.

(How did you get to school?)

Well, you took us there in September and we stayed there until well we came home for Thanksgiving and Christmas and holidays but we stayed there until the closure of the school.
