MEALS:

(How many times a day did you eat when you were growing up? Was there any certain number of...)

Three times a day, and I still practice that today. Three meals a day morning, noon, and evening.

(What sort of things did you have for meals? Like did you have anything special for breakfast for example?)

Well, as far as I'm concerned, we had plenty of milk and butter. For breakfast and then we had plenty chickens and there was always eggs and there was always bacon. We had plenty to eat.

(Was one meal bigger than another one? Was there a main meal?)

At noon.

(You ate the most at noon?)

UHuh.

(About what time did your family go to bed usually?)

Well, about nine or ten o'clock.

(About what time would they have supper?)

Well, pretty early cause grandma was one of these, she expected us children to eat and then play around a while. She said it wasn't good
