But mostly, they use Bois'darc?

(Yeah. How-how they shape-how they fix the Bois'darc to make a bow out of it? How they shape it?)

Well, oh, sometimes--they say it's better when the Bois'darc seasoned, you know.

· (Yeah.)

When it seasoned. I see some of those guys take a big old (not clear).
