BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Eula Hill was born in 1916. She has lived in the Canton area all of her life. She is married to Gilbert Hill. She went to school in Concho and Chilocco Indian schools until 8th grade at which time she married. Eula has had a short period of training as a nurse's aide. She speaks both English and Cheyenne languages.
