He tells that there was a time when the Indians built houses and never used a nail in them. All fitting of logs and planks was by dovetailing and wooden pins. He tells how clapboard shingles were made by using a froe and mallet. He went out and brought in the froe he has had for a long time, and which used to belong to his father. Blocks of red oak or white oak were best for making the clapboard shingles.
