

about a Baptist church, Indian church there in Canton and he say he got nothing to do with it. But still he's got something to say about it.

(Is there much difference between the native American church and these other churches?)

There's one thing I can tell you about this church. They go in there in reverence. And they don't come out unless they get permission from the priest. They can't go in and out without getting permission. A lot of churches, they get up and go when they get good and ready. But you can't do it in a native American church. They get permission. So there's a lot of difference between the churches.

(Do they have regular meetings?)

Oh, yea.

(Do they have a lot of members?)

That's the biggest organization in the state of Oklahoma. Nation-wide.

(Do the children go to the meetings?)

Not unless they are sick or something. That's sacred. In other words, my people go in and worship. When they go in a holy place they remove their shoes. But they don't do it nowadays. Another thing. I've seen people today they put money on the Bible. After they get through they put it in their own pockets. That's not right. That's God's money. If everyone would get out of their own, be disciples, so that's one reason Indians don't believe in denominations. That's about all I can tell you unless I get permission from the chairman.

(Do the Arrapho's and Apaches have separate branches of this native American church?)
