And then they put this dough in it and they set the lid on top of it and they have the lid on the fire to get it hot, just set it over the fire and when it gets hot they move it on this Dutch oven and then they have some of that coal and you know, put it over that lid to keep it hot, both sides and the bottom. And they let it stay there, not too long and here it comes out nice and brown on both sides and fluffy you know, and they really make good bread out of it. That's what I call Dutch oven bread.
