(Is there anyway to get rid of it?)

Yes. There's one medicine to get rid of it. I could fix them up and get them alright.

(Could you tell me some of those?)

I got medicine hat could heal it...straighten that mouth pp and that eyes. You could get well, but there's hardly any Indians living today that understand that way. They all die. Indians up today, the Comanches, I don't know about the Kiowas, I don't think there in anybody in the Kiowa tribe that understands all except one old man, but they say that he don't make you get well, he don't straighten your face out. That's what I heard. I know among the Comanche tribe I never did hear of any-one living today that could heal them. If you don't get it doctored they say the longer you have it your face just get twisted and you have a slobbery mouth all the time and your eyes be watery and after a while you can't see too good in your eyes no more. You can blurs your eyes. When you sleepy you can't see good, you know, just like that. That's what it does to anybody got...that way you know.

(Now did you say the Comanches don't have anything to cure it?)

They have you know but most of the ones that used to doctor that, they all died. They never did teach their childrens how to go at it and be a doctor for that purpose. Lots of times, I know way back in years there was old people who understand real good about it. Their childrens up to today don't know a thing about it. They never did get it from their parents or either their parents never did learn it to them or how
