Now today they try to have pow-wows. They had one up here last week and you don't see them moccasins...the woman folks got moccasin, shawls and blankets, like us full-blooded Indians, because they don't know nothing about it. Way back in years the older people...they don't know nothing about dancing. They just there. They don't go visit other Comanches. That's there group over there.. They don't associate with the other tribes. But us ones in here there different tribes of Indians but they all Comanches. Got different names like you said and they all be togheter. They assoicate with one another and they have pow-wows together and they got drums and they got moccasins and they got all Indain costumes. But over there you can't hardly find any, but they said now they trying to get some people to make them buckskin dresses for the young girls and the youn boys to learn how to-dance. At that pow-wow, they didn't have no drum, they didn't have no singers, they don't have nothing. They have to invite some people from Lawton to go up there and dance for them.
