it from there, but they sure give you little bitty pieces...for a dollar.

(Did you ever doctor anybody that had a snake bite?)

No I mever did. But when my boy, you know the one up there in Geary, when he's going out to the hay field like now, I have it boiled and I just rub it on his leg like that and then I get a cloth and tie it in there, tie it around his boots you know, and when ... if there's a rattle sanke running right there, he be right up on him but he won't jump him. He smell that and just lay low. It'll kill that rattlesnake right now. I don't know how it does it; but I always put it on his feet like that.

(You'boil it and make a tea out of it?)

Yes, I just spill it all over his leg and then it just smell like that all day. And if he run into a rattlesnake they smell that and they won't bite him, they just go backwards and lay low, because that medicine is real strong. They ain't going to smell it. They going to die if they smell it.

(Are there any medicines for pregnant woman?)

No. But they give them some kind of tea so they could you know pass it quick. But this medicine...well, I don't think a woman should have it too quick because you know how it does...they baby comes and it just tears you up. If it comes out too fast. I seen it done where the mother say...this one old lady, my mothers in-lay, my brothers wife's mother, she was a real old lady and anybody that's going to have a baby she gives them that because she waits on peoples when they going to have baby, and she always gives them that medicine but it goes to fast sometimes. it tears them down there. We don't have no doctors to sew them up like
