Yeah, they got medicines for those. My cousin, she had that all the time and about a month ago, she come over here and I fixed her up and she never did have it yet. Going on two months now. She had it all the time. She was about the size of you. Small woman. I fixed her up and she never did do that no more. All right now. She used to shake and get stiff and sometimes she would grip her tongue and cut it... she would shake and then get stiff...her legs would get stiff and she'd pass out.

(Do you know what caused that?)

No, I don't know but this the only thing that I understand is use this medicine and then they get all right.
