I didn't tell her to quit the doctor or nothing. My other sister she the one who told her, "Why don't you go over to older sisters and let her fix you up so you could get well." She did. She come over here. I fix her up. She never did get sick again.

(Where did you get your medicine practice from?)

From my mother. She learn me all those medicines.

(Was she a doctor?)

Yes.

(Was this transferred from her mother?)

From her father. Her father was a doctor. Her father taught her how to do this and that and showed her all the medicines what's she's going to use. I never did take care of anybody that going to have a baby but one. My nephew's wife, it was her first child. Took care of her. After that I never did take care of them. I was afraid somebody might report me because I ain't got no license or nothing. I don't my Indian way I used to be afraid to doctor anybody, you know. If they going to the doctor and they don't get well and the next time they go up and they well, the doctor ask them how they get well, and then they might report me and that's why I don't like to doctor anybody anymore. Just on that account.

(Can you pass this on to somebody?)

I guess I can but you know, it costs lots of money. I made lot of money all time when I doctor anybody. They pay me good, real good.
