MARY POAFYBITTY'S RELIGION:

(There was something else I wanted to talk to you about. The other day you were talking about the peyote church. I was wondering, how can you be a Christian and a peyote member at the same time?)

I was baptized long time ago in the year 1910 or 12, I was baptized. My mother said I was sprinkled on my head. Priest over here carried me to the altar and sprinkled my head when I was just a little bitty baby. And after that--after so many years after that, oh, that'll be 1910 or 11 or 12, right in there, I was baptized and ducked under the water. Baptized you know, by a preacher. He used to have this church over here west of Lawton. It's still out there--that church. Cemeteries up there,

(What was that church called?)

We just call it Deo's church. The preacher, his name was Deo. The reverend Deo, and he was the second preacher that came among the Comanches. But this man that live over here, he was the first one among the Comanches. He start preaching and he was second one.

Creëgis.

C h r i s t i a n. I guess. I forgotten now.
