Some 30 tribes are to be fourd inthe state with Kiqwas; Comanches and Kiowa-Apache and a -- of Geronimp Apaches, sóme Caddoes, Delawares and others in the southwestern section. Here are no reservations in this area. The tribesmen and thier family feside on restricted 160 acre allotments, granted them when finaliy arrangements wer made with the signing of the Jerome agreement in 1892. Troyb\&e between the Indiasns in Oklahoma and the government subsided with the sign/ng of the Medicine Lodge Kansas treaty in 1867. Included in the various tribes were whites, Mexicans, some Negroes and others captured and rear£d with the Indians. They wre also given allotments and shared equal privileges. M embers of several tribes were grouped together, such as was dane in the early days when there were German, Bohemian and othex nationalftet residing in settlements.
