where I was there but I couldn't tell. (Well, who was--I was talking-- do you know Georgia Williams?) Georgia Williams. Uh-huh. Here in Atoka? (Uh-huh.) Wh-huh. She's my cousin. (1s, she?) Uh-huh. (Well, Georgia was telling me -- we visited with them, last night a while and she was telling that she thought where the Baptist Church is now is what use to be the old Atoka Baptist Academy.) Yeah, that's where use to be our church. That's where J.S. Monroe was our preacher. White man. (J.S. Monroe.) Uh-huh. (, White man?) Uh-huh. (Now that's the one that Pop and Gilbert Danie were talking about this morning that started it. Started the Atoka Academy.) Um-hum. (Well, you didn't have brothers or sisters there with you then?) No. I didn't. (You just went along by yourself?) By myself. And stay there and I quit. Yeah, I ain't got no sisters I just had grown--Solomon Homer was my brother but he was my half-brother My name was Durant and his was Homer. His name was Homer. My daddy's name is John Durant.

(John Durant?)
