BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Mrs. R. W. Challis was about 75 years of age at the time of this interview. She moved to Indian Territory in 1903 with her family to what is now Garfield County, Oklahoma. She married Mr. Challis in 1910 and moved to Caddo County and has lived there since that time. Mrs. Challis moved in to Carnegie in 1962. She and her husband leased part of their farming and grazing land from the Indians for many years.
