(What kind of a person can be a doctor? Just anybody can't be one, can they?)

No. Not just anybody. There's two Comanche man--back here and they doctor. They don't know nothing about that crooked face.

(What are their names?)

John (Comanche name) and Oliver (Comanche name). They brothers.

(Uh-huh.)

They got this peyote medicine they know how to doctor with this peyote.

(Do you know any other Comanche doctors?)

There's one young, young boy. He's about your age I guess, or older maybe.

Yeah, he's older than--just like you--John is his uncle, grandson. His uncle was a doctor and then when he got old, he was the--this young man was his grandson. And he had four daughters. And those daughters refused to take it.

They can't do nothing with it. They don't know how to do anything but they said to their father. So he turn around and give it to his grandson. And

now today his grandson's got it but he don't know how to do this crooked face. He doctors with peyote but he don't know nothing about this (not clear).

I seen him. He came in two or three times to our peyote meeting.

(Is there anybody, any Comanche other than you that knows about this?)

Woman?

(Yes, both of them.)

No, there's no woman among the Comanche don't know nothing about that.

(Are there any of the men that know about it? I mean how to treat it?)

Huh-unh. Nobody.

(There is static on tape--objects being moved around.)
