(If we don't have time today, are you free tomorrow?)
We got time today.

(Well, you know what I'd really like to do is go out with you. If you've got the time, I've got the car.)

You know right now, it's a cool night we could walk. We have to walk for that stuff. (Mary is calling to someone else--someone named George. She says that George knows where the find the herbs they are looking for easily. She had a hard time finding them.) Tomorrow is Friday. I have to go in town tomorrow.

(Well, could we just go out or --?)

Lets see what--Friday or Saturday--you be right where--where the place you going to stay?

(Oh I can stay anywhere, I can sleep in my bus. I sleep anywhere I want to.) You could stay here over-night.

(Well you said you have to go away tomorrow, don't you?)
