(Don't they use the eagle feather to help in peyote meeting?)

Yeah. They have it in peyote meeting. (Sentence not clear--speaking about peyote.)

USE OF CEDAR SMOKE

(Why do you use cedar so much? Smoking with other doctors.)

We smoke our own. Like tonight, we build fire and get that coal. One of us have to smoke all over the place. Then we throw it away and then come in. And then every night if you want to. That means you're going to sleep good and get well. Won't be any kind, no kind of thing that scare you is going to be in there, your home.

(Why do you always use it before you doctor?)

They say that when you use that—say that when you smell that cedar the smoke they inhale it. It goes all back up and the pains go away from you. Take it away with that smoke. Lot of things—they say that it keeps you well and there you won't be scared of nothing. Lot of people they think it helps you right then. You feel dizziness in your head and you smell this stuff you're alright. That's what it's for, you know.

OTHER MEDICINES AND ROCK MEDICINE

(About how many things that scare you.)

Oh I don't know. I got all kinds of different—all the ones I'told you.

That's all different kinds of medicine I use but I can't get hold of them.

That's one medicine we get at Wichita Falls—way up in that mountain—on
the side of that mountain, it's just full of it. And it's just like this,
when we going after it—it's stuck to the rock. They're bigger than those—
oh about that big—it's stuck on to those where them hills come down way
up there. You go up there and just get out there and park and walk that way.

It's high, got high cliff banks. All in there, them rocks, just get a sack
