But anyway, you'd cut that like this and get one design. Out if you but it this way you'd get another design, and if you cut it cross here you get anotherone. And he showed me those things and tried to get my nusband to take his equipment 'cause, you know, he past using them. And he had the lasest equipment, you know. He had electric things and he - now he got two and half for every little piets of black rock ne cut off there. You know, to bring people out here to make these rings, you know, you'd get a contract with them to sell the stones. But then you got to have this equipment. Course now you san make a cut-stone out of this glass. We had some out of it and I don't know where he got his plass, it looks so natural. And he had some - well meople like me - I couldn't tell it from diamonds, it was just so - and trat is just as hard as a diamond. You justpick at up and scratch down across. Mell, you know, ( Inintelligible) but you know Oklanoma had some of the pest sand anywhere in the world for making glass. And what did they do with it? And it all washed off down to the sea. They even quit making some the glasware here. This guy came in from England. Yee. And he set, up - I don't know whether set up in Ada or where - but somewhere east of Oklahoma Jity.
