'course now you can make a cut-stone out of this glass. He had some out of it and I don't know where he got his glass, it looks so natural. And he had some - well people like me - I couldn't tell it from diamonds, it was just so - and that is just as hard as a diamond. You just pick it up and scratch down across.
