much beans up here, dause of deer.

( Deer eat the beans?)

Yeah. Deer eat all them bears I got. And they don't bother no corn.

( Don't bother the corn?)

And Kraut either, and tomatoes they don't eat. Just the beans, that's all.

( You told me that you don't have any children.)

No.

( But you raised lots of other children.)

Unhunnh. Other children.

( Have there been grandchildren? - Neices and nephews?)

Yeah. That's all.

(What was the name of the one that you were telling me about that you raised over here to the school and is in North Carolina?).

Oh. Søldier Sanders.

( Sordier Sanders?)

Unhunnh. Yeah.

('Was he' a grandson or nephew?)

My sister's boy. Yeah. I keep him and I raise him since he was 13 months old. And then he want to go to school - that training school. And he just graduate and then he stayed up there a little while and work in bank. And he got wife. They live up there in training school long time. And wife wants to go back in North Carolina. That's where she is from. She went back and teach out there. He find a job all right. He working in post office in North Carolina.
