He has the reasoning he has taken things item for item, he does not take things for granted. This is the Cherokee that walks proud among his people. And the Cherokees believe that there is some spirit man greater than any other man that walks among them. As the sun comes up and as the sun goes down and the night follows, they feel nearness, more so than any other religious person or denomination that I can ever talk to or come across. This is the great thing of the traditional Cherokees. (Several feet of tape is blank on the end of side A.)
