raise horses. White horses, and cows. They got about eighty head of cattle. Have lots of meat to eat.

(Did all of the Indians have horses or were there some people that didn't have any?)

Some people don't have any. Some peoples are poor. They're not well off like my mother. My mother--I don't know how she get well off. She got everything. She got wagons, howses. She get some boys to tame her horses--wild horses. She pay them and they tame them.

(Do you know what she paid them?)

She paid them. I don't know how much she paid them. I don't hardly study about that.

(Some irrelevant conversation.)

(I wanted to go back to what we were talking about when you got sick and you got over it. And then what happened to you? Did you go back to school?)

No, I got married. Yeah.

(Who did you marry?)

I marry a second time. My first man is Joshua Kaulity (kole.te). After he pass away I marry her daddy. That's all I got married. And now I'm single now.

(What's her daddy's name?)

Mausape, M-A-U-S-A-P-E. Mausape.

(Did he have a first name?)

No.
