(Unintelligible." - - all kind of Indians - - they got tombstone up the mountains. That's what I see in cemetery - - four thousand. I thought he done the work and (Unintelligible work) - - that's Big Bow story, yet. And after he went Washington. - - Grandpa went to Washington. And I guess somebody interpret for him. "You want the school house? Kiowa School?" And Government said, "Big Bow, you're too right." Tell him about the war(?) stop the war. They like him, Government. "Well, we'll help you put up the Indian big school house." "What you going call it?" "Kiowa School, they said. Kiowa school, - - school, Anadarko, right there. That way, they call 'em Kiowa school." Big building, four story high. That's what he done. Big Bow Story. And Mountain View -- went of Mountain View - - I was boy that time, over four years old, Big Bow, come out there, some where. Got white men - - three - - two white men and Big Bow. He can't stop any home at their camp. And he come, he stop here, horseback. And he ask him, my dad, "Dad, what they doing?" "Oh, I want get the Sun Dance over with. I want all them dumb kids - - the six year old, seven years old, I want send 'em to school Anadarko in Kiowa school." They all got ready to go
