Yeah. My grandmother's brother. He's (Rowledge) got a history of it. History of Little Raven and on my mother's side, White Wolf is my grandfather--my mother's father and he's got a history of him too. Whenever I go down there I can get them at his house.

(Go to Geary?)

Go to Geary and get them. I sure like to get hold of it, because he's getting old. If his daughters get hold of them they ain't going to give it to me. At that Medicine Lodge Treaty, the way they fix it now, this Maria, Arthur's wife, their great grandfather was the chief he signed the treaty, but my grandfather was the first one that signed the treaty. White Wolf, and she said your grandfather's name wasn't--no White Wolf was on there and I said, "His Indian name was on there. You don't know him. You was too young to know anything but I got this from my mother and my uncle Jesse (Rowledge). He knows.

(Do you know what White Wolf's Indian name was?)
