Well, they'd rather borrow it from Huff. The local Indians, there. But those distant Indians all borrowed from the bank. (Why would they rather borrow from Huff?) ( Well, they were local Indians and they knew him and he knew them. Sort of a friendly gesture, I guess. But those that the bank didn't know--like from Red Moon, Elk City, and those places, they came in with security. And I knew them. I vouch for them. I interpreted for them.

(Would the bank ever make loans to other Indians, like Kiowas--?) No, no.
