You know Indians, long time ago, they doctor with some kind of herbs, or something, you know. They dig them out of the earth and doctor like that.

(You said Mary could doctor. Do you know of any old people other then Mary who know those medicines?)

Mary said?

(I was wondering if there were any old people who used those old medicines I don't even know. I don't know if the others know it or not. I know of just her knows it among our Comanche peoples.

(Have you ever heard of the Padoponi brothers? Comanches?)

Yeah.

(Are they doctors?)

Yeah, they said they was doctors but I never did see them doctor anybody. That's what I heard that they doctors but I don't know.
