WITCHING:

(You have told me about things that your mother and uncle did as doctors but that you don't do. Can you tell me anything else like that that you don't do?)

There's one thing that I know. If anybody done wrong and you don't never like them--won't have nothing to do with them no more. Old Indians my granmother told me this--said this old man goes out or the woman that's had trouble that had trouble with this other woman. Anything like that. They would go out and sit alone for four days and fast and pray and cry. You know, they hold their hands like this right up here.

(Pinch their skin?)

Yeah, up like that and just cut it with a sharp knife like that and cut it through here clean across it. ((pinch skin up then puncture fold of skin)) they put a buckskin in it and they tie it and when--oh, I don't know how long--they wear it like that. And then they take this plum of eagle and they make a hole in bottom like that, (bottom of feather and put that buckskin in there and tie it by that long bucksin and take it and tie it up in tree just as far as they could reach they tie it up there and that plum just, you know how it is, it just go around, and around, and around. Sometimes it--in the tree somewhere and as long as the plumes up there tied to that tree, that man's going to live. When it breaks off, he's dead.
