We set down on the west side of the plant and faced east toward the medicine and my brother-in-law prayed--George Pryor. And while he was praying, this medicine appeared all around us which we didn't see when we set down as we prayed. That was my first experience.

(What did he say--George--when he looked at the medicine--the first one he saw?

What did he say--how did he say it in his prayer?)

The beginning of his prayer, he said, "Our medicine, we come here--come after you to take you home with us, some medicine here so we can have our ceremonies and worship God in our Indian American church, and for sick people and for our ceremony uses only." And during his prayer there, well, a lotta medicine come out. We gather it. We see it all around while we were sitting down on the ground.

(Did it seem to come out of the ground as he prayed?)

It seemed to appear while he was praying all around here and there. You could look different directions around us. See this medicine like it popped out of the ground from some place that we never seen when we got there. That was the experience I wanted to go and see. And that's what I saw. So we gathered up some of the medicine and brought it home. So, that's my first experience in how it grows when go and pick it up for your own use and experiment.
