(And did ba bibah, live there too?)

Yeah, but he's in Ft. Sill soldiers, you know, he don't stay there.

(Did he ever marry, ba) bibah ?)

Yeah, I know he marry a long time.

(Do you know who he married?)

Yeah, I know but you don't know Josie's mother--long time.

Josie Star? She married my uncle when I was young.

(Yeah, what was her name?)

Who?

(Josie Star's mother?)

hinilgoh, his name. Josie's mother. hinilgoh She married my uncle.

(Did they have any children?)

No.

(Did, bà' bibàh have any children?)

No, he ain't got none.

(Did he and Apache Ben have any other brothers or sisters?)

My uncle Ben, that's all two of them. You mean that?

(Yeah, was there any other brothers or sisters?)

No.

(Let's see there was your mother. Did she have any sisters?)
Yeah, she's got sister.

(What was her name?)

I don't know that, my mother's sister's name. Because something--I don't know. It's hard, I guess. I don't know his name much, you know. I was a little girl that time. She died that woman, you know, I don't know her name.

(Do you remember her?)

I see her, but I don't know her name.

(Let's see, ba'bibah would be your mothers' brother, too?)
Yeah, same father and same mother.

(Were there any other Apaches living down around Cement when you were growing up?)

No. Just our folks, that's all. My grandparents, that's all. All Apaches, they live at Cache Creek.

(How come your grandpa got his land down there at Cement instead
