They were known to eat peoples.

(What does [^]da[^].[^]da[^]he[^] mean?)

That's what I was trying to tell you. I don't know what's it's the abbreviation of. There's just one person left that I can get information from, and I don't know if she knows it or not. That's Louise. Canna May was the one I was gonna see. I kept waiting on it, and waiting on it--I was gonna go down there. I was gonna find out through her.

(What about the Lipan? What did the Kiowa-Apaches call them?)

Well, [^]da[^].[^]da[^]he[^]. and we call 'em another name--that might be the Lipans --that's [^]ceda[^] si[^] a[^]he[^]. And I believe they're the Mescaleros, too, but since they have two names--they couldn't have two names. [^]ceda[^] si[^] a[^].hi[^] that means they got a piece of--you seen that--Gussie wears them-- look like (indicating turned up toes of moccasins)

(That flap that sticks up on their moccasins?)

Yeah. That's what it's called--[^]ceda[^] si[^] a[^].hi[^]. e--that's people with that kind of shoes. And that could of been the Lipans. That could be Mescaleros. But they call 'em [^]da[^].[^]da[^]he[^]. too.

(What about the Jicarilla Apache. Did you all have a name for them?)

They're all in the bunch--I don't know. [^]da[^].[^]da[^]he[^]. [^]ceda[^] si[^] a[^].hi[^] [^]ko[^]di[^]ca[^]he[^]. and I forgot--another tribe. There's two or three tribes.
