

from there. They took me away from there before but this time, I just can't get away from here. If you have to kill me, before you take this land away from these people. So if your government want to fight, I'm going to get on this mountain here, and if you want to fight - follow me, I fight." So he did - went out on that mountain and then the rest of us they told us to ride in ten columns about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles east from agency. And we stayed there. We had a good time. A nice time. The people like it. It's all our old chiefs, there with us, why everythings alright. But later on, why somehow there's telegram from New Mexico Mescalero Reservation to San Carlos, they said that Geronimo is fighting out there. So this Warm Spring Apache scout, all the young men they went up there to New Mexico, Mescalero Reservation. Well the rest of them older people stay home. Then later on, why Geronimo coming in with his men. Then early in the morning, he had to surround us with his men on horse back, right there. Then he said, - take - everybody going out off the creek. If somebody don't want to go, why just kill 'im right there - shoot 'im down. He go round and tell his men like that. Then I was standing right there. I was standing between the tent, I look and I seen him coming from San Carlos. I seen a man coming on horse back, he was lopping, and coming closer and closer - after while one of these Geronimo's men, he got off. He was riding in front on the horses, he look at that man. That man coming there, he was a white man, he's the agent, he come in there, right close to him he shot him - shoot him down right there. He kill him. Then they took us up the creek. All of us. They took us all there on these - east San Carlos River, on that mountain there - on the south - on the north side of the mountain and its clear down to - to east from - Duncan. I guess, I don't know whether there or not. We went throught there and we went into Old Mexico close to New Mexico, where the little town there - they just go through that little
