like to know what it is. Maybe the things that you seen, we like to know them."

So this young man says, "All right." So he told him certain day: So that certain day came, well they fix everything up just like he told 'em to fix it. So that's how these Tonkawas, they learn this Native American Church way. So this young man, he show them peoples in there how he was conducting, how it's carried on, and what it meant to the people he got acquainted with. That's the way the Tonkawas learn it.

This young man that we was talking about, he was a Tonkawa. And this Lipan Apache, that's the one that—the people that he seen down there—got acquainted with, and knowing them.
