west of us here. And she said that when my father died ... she said," I raised my hands up to the heavens, to the Almighty, and promised that I wouldn't ever remarry, that I didn't want my children to be mistreated by another man." And so that's the way - I had a good mother, I'm proud of her, and she taught me all these ways of doing. So she stayed with my sister for a few years. And then my uncle was living right here where I'm living now - a mile from my sister's, where my mother was. And so when my other sister, that's when my father was married to sisters and so that left two widows ... tape ends.
