Just to be knowing how to tan. He wanted to know how to tan so he had to try it. They came out good. Yeah.

(Did you tell him how to do it?)

No. I don't tell him nothing. He tried to ask me how to bead, but I told him you have to learn yourself in your own way. Boy, when he did learn how to bead, he sure can bead good. And he's quick. He's quick about everything. But me, I'm slow. (Did the Arapaho women ever use a loom to make anything like belts—a frame for making beadwork?)

Oh, yeah, when they make belts. I never did do that kind.
When I was in school I used to make them but when I left school
I quit.
