You see, they try to go and take Custer but they couldn't.

No, they didn't know what. They always say that he killed everyone of them off, but he didn't. Some of them escape from there.

((GLADYS MANN)) My brother father he escaped from that bunch--a young teenager I guess you might call him.

((LAURA BIG HORSE)) And these Indians, Cheyennes, say that he smoke the peace pipe with them. You always read it in a book--Custer was, he smoke the peace pipe with them. Cheyennes did. Supposed to make peace with them, but he broke that treaty. He attacked them there and then he attacked them somewhere else. Twice he broke the treaty. They say that the reason why those Cheyenne help kill of his whole cavalry. They gang up on him, and the Cheyennes and Sioux, and Arapaho--where them northern tribes run--Montana and Wyoming. They gang up on him, and that's how they kill everyone of them. They always say that one white man lived but the way the Indians tell it, none of them lived. They take care of every one of them. And for long time they wouldn't tell who really killed him. They tell just recently. They always say it was that (?). He wasn't no Cheyenne. They captured him--they Cheyenne. He was a Ute.
