Third Voice: We learned A B C and stuff.

(Let me see, is that Archer school, they still call that Archer Community, don't they. When did this close?)

Third Voice: Oh, I probably couldn't tell you exactly when they closed.

(McNair school, that was on further south then.)

Third Voice: That was about five miles south, up toward that hill toward Slapout.

(Where was Slapout located?)

Third Voice: Well, it was right down here in this area--I could show you the very spot.

(When was that?)

It was about 1907.

(1907. That was probably the old school house. And then Bryant Chapel, was that an old community?)

Third Voice: Well, that's over here--I'm goin' this area right now. And then there was another right across the river here called Grant. And Raymond Bewley taught there.

(Hear about the Holman Institute.)

Well, let Pixie tell you a lot about it.

(Where was it?)

Third Voice: It was across the river. I could take you right to that spot. It was five miles from the old Dr. McNair's place, just directly east. And I stayed--you know Dr. McNair's family--
