with. We have court houses. We had to go through trials, anything like that, in big trouble. Well, it's done away with.

(Have you ever known of anybody yourself that has gone to those men to get something settled like that?)

Jenny: Well, like he told you, it's mostly the trouble like what he told you-about his brother-in-law you know, killed a man, accidently shot him. But the relatives didn't think that. They wanted to kill him. He was a young man. So he had to kind of hide away from the tribe, till they make peace with one of those priests. And they were all in peace, then.

(Well, you said one of those bundles burned up.)

Jenny: Yes. That's the one White Horse had. It's not this young boy--you might know him. There's two boys, I think, that are White Horse. It was their father that had it. It came from his father or maybe his grandfather. And they had it tied up in a basement. And I don't know how that house got burned up. It burned the whole thing, and that thing burned up. The whole burned up. The house burned up, and so that thing was tied in there, and it burned up.

(When did that happen?)

Jenny: Oh, it happened when White Horse's, that idol burned up, it happened about twenty years ago?

Cecil: That White Horse idol. But they're supposed to keep those idols in a tipi. They're not supposed to keep them in house, or cellar, or anywhere else. So this White Horse, he had this idol tied up in his bedroom, on the wall.

Jenny: In the basement. That's where the house burned up and went down and burned that thing up.

Cecil: Well, anyhow, he had it in the house. And the house caught on fire. And it burned it up. So that left just nine. Today
