Leroy Logan is about 59 years of age. He is the only son of Roman and Mary Logan. He lives in Hominy Indian Village with his wife Mary, an Omaha and their daughter. His first wife was Oto. Mr. Logan is a council member of the Osage Nation Organization and serves on the Hominy War Dance Committee. He is a very popular speaker and is asked to speak at many of the formal meetings of the Osage Tribe.
