And they come so far as, as he went along and began to tell these things so then they call him God. They said he was God, and he would tell things like that. He'd always help them, guide 'em and lead them. There was things that'd - that he'd- told them that worked good for them. So that's why they....so then this order - but that's another story too, this order that they had, the Osages they said he had to be chiefs to be in there, but he wasn't no chief, he wasn't from a chiefs family. So they put him in there too. They made a place for him in there. They gave him a special seat in there in through clans and all that they had. So that's the way they done him too. So he was pretty powerful with this group, I guess. And they came off-they were down this way. I guess they're the ones that come with that Cheateau. So they were down in here and they went far as Texas, they been all down in there. He's been all over the western part, in the mountains over there. He talks, he tells them about them things, all those things he tell 'em. So then they came here and they were around here and then the civil war started, they were 'round here. So they just stayed around here. So that's why we were down here when these things were going on, up there in Kansas. When they was moving them out of Kansas, and they was down here when they made this 1808 treaty. They were off over here around Salina and Claremore and back in there. They went back and these other two groups, they made this 1808 treaty, that was from Missouri, they went back over there again. They say we better come back, so they went back they was making that treaty. They had already got it up, I guess, pretty good, the way they was wantin' to do. And here this other group come in. So they had to wait. These army, whoever they was dealing with, they had to wait on them, so finally that's how they were in on that too. They come and got in on that treaty. They were here during the civil war, when they started talking about selling
