She said these are (Kate speaks Cheyenne) -- They initiate one another, this Real Bull's clan.

Kate: (speaks Cheyenne)

They initiate them by feeding them dog. That's for full-fledged members.

(I think I might misunderstand. So to make sure, do you mean that Real Bull's clan would initiate the members into the Lantern Dance group? And the Lantern Dance group would--?)

No, she's just using this one for an' example -- this Lantern Dance.

A See, there's four of each. Four war bonnets, and four whips.

Maybe she meant that way. And this one was running along that order she said.

(You mean Real Bull's group had war bonnets?)

No. This was a different organization. See, she's just using it for an example. See, she's telling you how many danced with war bonnets, and how many with those long trailers, and those swords--"swords," I guess you call them.

(What are they?)

No, I believe they have another name. (Cheyenne) I got to find out what she called them.

(Kate speaks Cheyenne. She is talking to a man who came up, asking him questions.)

They fast for four days. And then four days they dance. And they paint.

(Cheyenne conversation between Kate and the man)

They were painted like those Sun Dancers. (Kate speaks Cheyenne)
Then the fourth morning, they dance toward the river and wash
themselves off—the paint off. They wash. (Cheyenne) He said,
