And even in our armed forces today, we have still many of our braves that are giving their lives, as privates, many of them fliers, many of the sailors...wherever the battle takes its course, there is where we're represented by many of our young braves. And I'm sure that we'll be able to have more, and they'll be able to do more, if they receive a good education, and start out on life with an even break. In the past many of our young men have started out upon life and three strikes was against them to begin with because they didn't have the formal education some of them have today. Even though they were Indian, they had the traits of an Indian. They were backward, perhaps, but I'm sure that they'll be forward from now on. And we can look forward to even higher achievements that our tribe will be represented in the future.
