BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Guy Quoetone was born October 15, 1885. He is a Methodist minister, now retired and has been active in church work for many years. He is also a student of Kiowa history, having been interested in listening to stories told by the old-timers about life and happenings in the old days. He has written notes and memoranda concerning many of these happenings in recent years, but they are his own composition and from his memory of either viewing them or hearing them from other Kiowas. He has often served in the Indian police, and was an interpreter for the Surveyors when the country was opened up. At 82 he is laert, articulate, and seems to have a very good memory of things in past years. He is hard of hearing and sometimes misunderstands questions or must have them repeated.

Interview Situation: Interview took place in kitchen of Guy's, 12 miles south of Carnegie. Guy had some things to show me, some letters asking / him for information on Kiowa history, a xeroxed copy of a page from a book by Elsie Clews Parsons, some old photos, some of him own notes, etc. Conversation started on description of Kiowa conjuring taken long ago from Kiowa prisoners at St. Augustine, Florida. Guy was comparing the written account with his own experience.
