think there are Indian children today who don't have at home the proper guidance and the proper encourgaement maybe. They are sometimesare given in to too quickly by the parent. And this in turn creates a situation where our young people may be are drop-outs or do not bursue careers and their life is wasted to a certain extent. So I think that if we would just take inventory of ourselves as people, as Indian people, or as an individual and try to convey in our own thoughts and have faith in ourselves as see le as we can accomplish and do, because a child must have security and must come from a home, because not only does not love alone accomplish a task, it takes discipline within ones self and I think the parent has to give this, and when the child doesn't have these things what we have today in this great America. We have disru tive civil disobedience and things of this nature, and a great deal of the fault does not lie with the young seonle alone. The guilt should be shared equally by the parent. And among Indian people in the time of my father and my time as a child it was very important that we listen to and respect our elders. We may not have agreed, but we certainly did respect them. And some of it rubbed off. And I see that his is not the way it is today. Our young people do not listen and do not heed. Because after all a person who has lived a good, full life, he certainly has picked up somethin; that is worthwhile to convey on to the younger generation. You don't live in vain, and as I was tellin; Miss Red Corn that I feel that this is jettin; away from the philosophy of the Indian that the idea of listenin; and responding to your parents was of the old school and today we do not find that this is arevelant in our Indian youn; seemle and maybe our Indian sarent today, he is taking up the ways of the dominant society in that he goes right alon, with the easiest way and that is torlet his children have their way. It is a lot harder to make them behave, a term we use so rech
