When I look back on this, it was very simple and yet it was a lot of fun. And the Nuns let us just use our own ideas about it. And then we had - always for breakfast, we would have - after we finished eating, everybody would do their own dishes at each table. And this was good training, too, because we learned to wash dishes properly, and didn't take us very long to get it done either. And then when I left St. Louis school and as a freshman I entered Loretta - the school sponsored by the Loretta Nuns at Webster Grove, Missouri - Webster college - and I think my coming was looked forward to with great anticipation because this was a full blood Indian girl coming from Oklahoma. And I was to be the first one to ever attend Webster College. And I must say that I was a great disappointment to them when I arrived with my trunk full of clothes, skirts and sweaters, just like all the other students. My saddle oxfords - and I was no different in my attire, maybe in personality. I readily made friends and I got along real well and in time they realized that there were Indians living outside of wigwags and not wearing feathers. And this was kinda educational to them and I felt proud that I was taken in and became a part of the activities at the college. I served as the freshman chairman of the party in October and made arrangements for all the activities and then I readily became treasurer of the freshman class. This all made up for a very happy association at Webster College. I stayed there one year. And then I came back to Oklahoma and went to Oklahoma State University. And at that time it was called Oklahoma A & M. And I became lost at A & M because it was too large and too many people and I could not adjust. Because I had been in a small school and knew everybody was a part of everything and at Stillwater I was just one of the masses and I could not get adjusted. So, I didn't stay there.
