Now that, you think that is enough for the peyote now?

HOW HUNTING HORSE BECAME A PEYOTIST:

(My other question was, did your father ever tell you when he started to take peyote?)

I can't exactly say just when, but it was through the talk or advice by his friend, Quanah Parker, perhaps way back in 1891. They were great friends, in using this peyote. 'Although Chief Quanah Parker wasn't a full blood--he was a half-breed. He was a half-breed. And both of them use it together as both brothers, and they invited each other to their peyote meetings. When my father had it, he invited Quanah Parker and when Quanah Parker had it, why he invites my father.

(Did they live close to each other?)

They live in the neighborhood of about -- about 0 miles apart. About 30 miles apart.

(Where did you r father live?)

My father lives between Mt. Scott and Saddle Mountain--in between Mt Scott and Saddle Mountain, and what they call his address, they call Mears, Oklahoman. Mears.

(Was this before they got alloted?)

Yeah.

ALLOTMENT: HOW HUNTING HORSE SELECTED ALLOTMENTS:

(And then where was his allotment after he got?)

His allotment was taken over there by Wichita Mountains up against—the government alloted him—my mother and my father together. 160 acres apiece. Because they were man and wife, they alloted them together up against the Wichita Mountains.

(Well, where was your allotment?)

Right here.

(I see. And this is 12 south of Carnegie? How come you're so far off from them?)
