we did on Labor Day.

I've never been up there on Sunday. I'd like to go up there sometime on Sunday. I'd like to hear those old Choctaw hymns.

Mr. Thompson: Ole Oliver did too - the hair just raised up on his head. ((laughter))

I can't understand, them but I always like to listen to 'em.

Mr. Thompson: It's been about four years since we were up there.

(Uh-huh, three or four anyway.)

Well, you wouldn't probably know the place. Oh you would too, but since they've modernized it.

Mrs. Oaks: It's been improved a lot since then.

There's been a lot of work down there; it looks nice. They keep it up.

Mrs. Oaks: Just as green.

Mr. Thompson: I guess they've got a caretaker there you know, that kind of kept the grass mowed.

They keep it up - maintained all the time now.

Mrs. Oaks: Yes, there's year-round caretakers now - its kept nice all the time.
