BACKGROUND OF INFORMANT:

Ruth Palmer was born in 1913 at Faxon, Oklahoma. Her first school attendance was at Ft. Sill School. She also attended Lawton High School. She has lived at Yellow Mission and Dio's Mission. Most of her life was spent with her grandmother Wake qway (Wom ah way ah). Mrs. Palmer is Kwahada Comanche though she has been living in an area of Kiowa pupulation density for the last twenty years.
