No Well yes there is a chimey in each end but this is a fíreplace and the other one wasnt. In fact there two-three chimneys, One is here and one in the middle, bute this is the on ly fireplace.
(You know all those stones are hand chipped, aren't they?)

(I. wiill bet that's it's mama there, isn't it?)

I believe it is too, and that's a mockingbird.
(We call them rain orows over home.)
Oh, was it? They may have been what it was. I juse seen it and $r$ thought:-
